PARENTAL AGREEMENT REGARDING RIGHTS OF THEIR CHILD (REN)

Each child who is a child whose parents are separated or divorced has certain rights. As parents, we agree that our child(ren) have the following rights:

- 1. The right not to be asked to choose sides between the child's parents.
- 2. The right not to be told the details of legal proceedings going on between the child's parents.
- 3. The right to understand that the impending child custody litigation and/or divorce action is not the fault of the child.
- 4. The right not to be told bad things about the other parent's personality or character.
- 5. The right to privacy when talking to either parent on the telephone.
- 6. The right not to be cross-examined by one parent after spending time with the other parent.
- 7. The right not to be asked to be a messenger from one parent to the other parent.
- 8. The right not to be asked by one parent to tell untruths to the other parent.
- 9. The right not to be asked to be a confidant regarding the legal proceedings between the parents.
- 10. The right not to be involved in the child support payment issues between parents and not to be made to deliver or demand child support payments.
- 11. The right to express feelings, whatever those feelings may be.
- 12. The right to choose not to express certain feelings.
- 13. The right to be protected from arguments and disputes between the parents.
- 14. The right not to be made to feel guilty for loving both parents.
